1	Name(s) of the Plaintiff	National Jute Board (NJB)
2	Court/Tribunal/Agency where the litigation is filed	Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta
3	Brief details of dispute/ litigation	The National Jute Board's money suit, was dismissed on August 6, 2025 by Learned Judge 5th Bench, City Civil Court at Calcutta as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh suit. The Company has filed an application before the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court against the order of Learned Judge 5th Bench, City Civil Court at Calcutta granting liberty to National Jute Board to file a fresh suit in the matter. The National Jute Board has filed a civil suit for refund of subsidy alleging wrongfully claimed by Company.
4	Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.	The expected financial implication cannot be determined at this stage as the matter is at an initial stage before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta.
5	Quantum of claims, if any	The Principal amount of claim for the said suit amounts to Rs. 1,02,43,393/- plus interest amounting to Rs. 2,52,61,748.14/-. However, given the fact of the matter, the management is quite confident that it will be decided in favour of our company.
